**LOCAL RULES** (To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- WATER HAZARDS** are defined as follows:  
RED STAKES - lateral hazard. YELLOW STAKES - water hazard.
- OUT OF BOUNDS:** White pegs with black tops define out of bounds + white and black markings - club house - carpark & all fences.
- G.U.R.** defined by white stakes.
- BALLS** lying in defined animal scrapes and prints, may be dropped, not nearer the hole - Without Penalty.
- OBSTRUCTIONS:** Immovable obstructions such as bridges and supports, tee boxes, irrigation

outlets, and tap covers. Relief may be taken according to Rule 24.1.

- PROTECTION** of young trees identified by stakes. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of their intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24.2b.
- PREFERRED LIES** of 1 club length, may be obtained between tee and creek on 15th hole.
- LINE OF SIGHT RELIEF** may be taken if practice green is between ball and green.
- OVERHEAD WIRES:** Ball striking overhead wires on 4th or 13th hole MUST be replayed.
- ROADS & CART PATHS** are an integral part of the course.
