LOCAL RULES To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf and Temporary Local Rules

as displayed outside the Pro Shop. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

Those areas beyond the inside line of white posts with black tops.

STAKED TREES

If a shrub or tree which is protected by a guard or is staked interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2.

TONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers (that are readily movable) are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1).

MMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

(a) STAKES

Red - Lateral Water Hazard White - GUR

(b) IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN

- The Specimen Local Rule is in effect (Rules of Golf, App.1/B/6).
- (c) DRAIN PITS including COVERS or GRATINGS
- Except in Water Hazards. (d) PATHS which are formed pathways.
- ROUND UNDER REPAIR
- (a) Areas the margin of which are defined by white paint or white stakes.
- (b) Clearly defined WHEEL RUTS made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle. (c) GARDEN BEDS - ONLY when marked GUR.
- - (d) Washaways in bunkers and at the margins of the bunkers.

DROP ZONES - marked by blue and white stakes

On the 2nd, 4th, 8th and 18th - see Local Rule Board.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only.

ENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Match Play - Loss of hole

Stroke Play - Two (2) strokes

DISTANCES ARE TO THE CENTRE OF THE GREEN

PINS Red - Front Yellow - Middle

Blue - Back

SAFETY & LIGHTNING POLICY/SIREN

It is the players responsibility to determine if weather conditions (including the threat of lightning) make play unsafe and to take appropriate safety action (including leaving the course). Should the course become unplayable or if there is potential danger from lightning or weather the SIREN may be sounded in which case players MUST immediately leave the course.

AND BUCKETS MUST BE CARRIED AND USED TO REPAIR DIVOTS.
